Missing & Murdered Indigenous Women (MMIW) March (Red Dress Day) MMIW has its title due to the disproportionate racism and de-humanizing towards Native women, but it does not mean that men, boys, and others are not facing similar experiences (aka the rates are just different). Presentation: Research of current parent populations – Most effective means for distributing information – Jennifer Risdall

Public Awareness Insights Report.

Anna Paulson introduced Jennifer Risdall. Jennifer and the Risdall teams have been working with Region 11 (and several other IEIC regions) since 2014. This project is a result of the 2023-24 Work Plan goal 2-2: "Research current parent populations and provide insight on the most effective means for distributing information to this generation."

Presentation highlights included:

- Audience
 - Focused on parents and caregivers of children birth-five
 - historically marginalized and new refugee families
 - o families who are in lower socioeconomic levels
 - families who have substantiated cases of abuse or neglect
 - families impacted by opioid crisis
- Tasks
 - research parent populations
 - research popular methods for communication

- Media Consumption Summary
 - TV usage has increased from 2022 to 2023 (Gen Zers are the least likely to watch live TV)
 - Streaming was the favorite platform for television reaching 35.9% of the overall viewing time.
 - weekly usage increased by .5% to 71.7%
 - Americans are streaming music more, 44.5% of the USA audience streams music everyday with YouTube music ranking #1 for streaming music and podcasts.
 - Social media platforms: still growing
 - Facebook, Youtube, Instagram, Snapchat, GooglePhotos, Tiktok
 - Instagram and WhatsApp are prevalent in Hispanic and Asian use. [Meg Thell mentioned that Hennepin County uses "WhatsApp" to push text messages to the Latina populations.]
 - Newspapers and magazines more users read digital newspapers than print. Non-English speaking parents with an income level of <30K are more likely to read paper newspapers because of a lack of internet access. This group is also most likely to get information from SmartPhones.
- Region 11 may look at specific radio stations based on information shared to the IEIC by community members for the African American community.
 - also looking at online radio to target Hispanic cultures and testing it for Somali and Hmong
- New goal is to always be thinking about mobile when targeting social media, as people with and without internet access are using their phones to get information.
 - Across every category, US adults that own a smartphone are greater than those with broadband.

- IEIC member Meg Thell is also on the development committee of the 80x3 website.
- Focused on children's mental health and trauma informed care
- Specific for childcare centers; not general to early childhood, but focused on center based experience in childcare centers.
 - variety of approaches and they have cohorts (places like YWCA has a cohort)

Congenital CytoMegalo Virus: Congenital Cytomegalo Virus (cCMV) Resource Webpage.

• Legislation was passed last session to include cCMV monitoring on the blood spot form at newborn screening. See the webpages for information on prevention of cCMV and on support strategies for families of children identified with cCMV.
